Allmaras Awarded NDU Education Scholarship

BISMARCK, N.D. – Ross Allmaras, of Carrington, N.D., has been awarded an NDU Education Scholarship from the North Dakota United Foundation for the 2015-16 year. Allmaras, the son of Conni Allmars, Carrington, will receive a cash award of \$1,000 to pursue a degree in Mechanical Engineering. NDU Education Scholarships are awarded to a student member of NDU, including student NEA/AFT members in other states, who are pursuing an undergraduate degree in education.

Allmaras is a senior at Carrington High School and will be attending North Dakota State University in Fargo this fall. At Carrington High School he's been a Science Olympiad participant and won 11 medals at regional and state level in engineering/building events. He's been involved in the Boy Scouts of America and has earned his Eagle Scout award. Since the summer of 2014, he's been working at the NDSU Research Center in Carrington.
